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**Town Board Meeting Minutes**

1. Call to Order --The monthly Board Meeting was brought to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairperson Cody Buerger. Present were: Chairperson Cody Buerger, Supervisor Robbie Pribnow, Supervisor Kurt Haefs, Treasurer Marcia Valle, Clerk Sharon Belling, Highway Superintendent Randy Dittberner. Also present were: Mayor Rob Boelk, City of Mayville, Cloey Potter, Molly Schroeder, and Alexis Kottke from Lomira High School.
2. Confirmation of Open Meetings notice – The clerk verified that the meeting was properly posted at the Town Hall & on the town’s website: [www.townoflomira.gov](http://www.townoflomira.gov). Notice was also given to the Dodge County Pionier.
3. Pledge of Allegiance -- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
4. Adopt Agenda– A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to adopt the agenda. Motion carried (3-0).
5. Approve minutes from previous meetings – A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to approve the minutes from the previous meeting and the special board meeting on April 21, 2026 and dispense with the reading. Motion carried (3-0).
6. Public comments - None
7. Discussion/Action items
  - a. A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to approve the Temporary ROW permit for Ries Hog Farms. Motion carried (3-0).
  - b. A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to approve Ordinance #2026-02 Amendment to Chapter 7 Driveway Ordinance. Motion carried (3-0).
  - c. A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to approve a driveway permit for Charles Cook at N11898 Center Dr. Motion carried (3-0).
  - d. The WEC Energy group has agreed to provide a corporate guarantee for any possible damages to Center Dr during repair of the wind towers. A road plan and permit will be executed in the near future.
  - e. A motion was made by K. Haefs and seconded by C. Buerger to purchase a road shouldering tailgate auger for \$13,790. Motion carried (3-0).
  - f. A motion was made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to have the new tandem axle truck lettered and then put in storage at A-OK Mini Storage (sub-leased from Troy Schmidt) until it can be customized at Burke Equipment. Motion carried (3-0).
  - g. Mayor Boelk presented different ways to partner with the City of Mayville in support of the TAG Center. The board was in agreement to offer a resolution of support in

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return for a 20% discount on 6 mo. and 1-year memberships for Town of Lomira residents. By offering a discount to area residents, memberships to the TAG Center will hopefully increase and help with the costs of operation
