- Call to Order --The monthly Board Meeting was brought to order at 7:07 p.m. by
 Chairperson Jeff Faber. Present were: Chairperson Jeff Faber, Supervisor Robbie Pribnow, Supervisor
 Kurt Haefs, Treasurer Marcia Valle, Clerk Sharon Belling, Highway Superintendent Randy Dittberner.
 Also present were: Kaylee Heeringa and Brenda Macht
- 2. <u>Confirmation of Open Meetings notice</u> The clerk verified that the meeting was properly posted at the Town Hall & on the town's website: <u>www.townoflomira.gov</u>
- 3. <u>Pledge of Allegiance</u> -- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- 4. <u>Adopt Agenda</u> Motion made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to adopt the agenda. Motion carried (3-0).
- 5. <u>Approve minutes from previous meeting</u> Motion made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to approve the minutes from the previous meeting and the April 26th special board meeting and dispense with the reading. Motion carried (3-0).
- 6. Public comments None
- 7. Discussion/Action items
 - a. Kaylee Heeringa and Brenda Macht were present to voice concerns regarding excavation activity and excess/junk vehicles at neighboring tax key #0303-1317-0114-003 owned by Cory Macht, Jr. The board will take a look at the property to determine if it violates the town's nuisance ordinance. Heeringa and Macht were advised to discuss their concerns about land use violations with the county.
 - b. Parking lots bids were received from Fleischman Excavating Inc. for excavation and stone placement in the amount of \$11,495.00 and E.L.B. Concrete Construction for the concrete work in the amount of \$20,400.00. Motion made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to approve the bids, but table the parking lot project to a later date due to needed salt shed repairs. Motion carried (3-0).
 - c. Road bids for opened for 2023 seal coating of portions of Butternut Rd and Ehrhardt Rd. Bids were received from Scott Construction, Inc. and Fahrner Asphalt Sealers LLC. Motion made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to accept the lowest bid which was from Scott Construction. Motion carried (3-0).

- f. Motion made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to approve a driveway permit on Butternut Rd. for Jeff Elsinger. Motion carried (3-0).
- g. Motion made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to approve an operator's license for Connor Murphy for Zedland Farm issued by the clerk on 5/2/2023. Motion carried (3-0).
- h. Committee appointments for possible future garage/shop expansion will be postponed to a later date due to the current focus on the salt shed repair/rebuild.
