## **Town Board Meeting Minutes**

- Call to Order --The monthly Board Meeting was brought to order at 7:00 p.m. by

- 2. <u>Confirmation of Open Meetings notice</u> The clerk verified that the meeting was properly posted at the Town Hall & on the town's website: <u>www.townoflomira.gov</u>
- 3. <u>Pledge of Allegiance</u> -- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- 4. <u>Adopt Agenda</u> A motion was made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to adopt the agenda. Motion carried (3-0).
- 5. <u>Approve minutes from previous meeting</u> A motion was made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to approve the minutes from the previous meeting and dispense with the reading. Motion carried (3-0).
- 6. Public comments None
- 7. <u>Discussion/Action items</u>
  - a. The bids for the Butternut Road project were opened and announced. Bids were received from Kartechner Bros. LLC, RLAM, Denny Rahn Excavating, Fleischman Excavating, and Kopplin & Kinas. The board tabulated and discussed the proposals and will award the winning bid at the town board meeting on May 13, 2025 or at a special board meeting.
  - b. Paving bids were opened and announced for 2025 road work. Bids were received from Northeast Asphalt Inc. and Kartechner Bros. LLC. A motion was made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to approve the bid (two lifts) from Northeast Asphalt for only Sunnyview Rd (0.5 mi.) at a cost of \$77,998.50. Water Street Rd may be re-bid at a later date. Motion carried (3-0).
  - c. Sealcoating bids for Center Drive from State Rd 49 to State Rd 175 were opened and announced. Bids were received from Scott Construction, Inc. and Fahrner Asphalt Sealers LLC. A motion was made by J. Faber and seconded by R. Pribnow to accept the lowest bid of \$47,843.00 (black granite stone) from Scott Construction. Motion carried (3-0).
  - d. A motion was made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to contract with Crack Filling Service Corp. for crack filling various town roads in 2025 not to exceed \$25,000. Motion carried (3-0).

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- e. A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to approve the Permanent ROW permit for TAK Communications WI LLC to install fiber optic cable along and under Rustic Rd. Motion carried (3-0).
- f. A motion was made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to approve a Temporary ROW permit for Christian Hill Dairy. Motion carried (3-0).
- g. A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to renew membership in the Wisconsin Towns Association and the Town Advocacy Council for the next year. Motion carried (3-0).

A complaint form has been filed with Dodge County.

- c. <u>Clerk's report</u> March permits: Peter Mittelstadt- electrical permit \$150.00 At the Spring Election on April 1, 2025, 520 voters cast their ballot for a 66.5% turnout.
- d. <u>Highway Superintendent's report</u> –The right of way along the curve on Water Street Rd will be reworked and ditched to make the water flow better.
