Town Board Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order --The monthly Board Meeting was brought to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairperson Cody Buerger. Present were: Chairperson Cody Buerger, Supervisor Robbie Pribnow, Supervisor Kurt Haefs, Treasurer Marcia Valle, Clerk Sharon Belling. Also present was: Josh Wiesner from the Boat Doc.
2. Confirmation of Open Meetings notice – The clerk verified that the meeting was properly posted at the Town Hall & on the town’s website: www.townoflomira.gov. Notice was also given to the Dodge County Pionier.
3. Pledge of Allegiance -- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
4. Adopt Agenda – A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to adopt the agenda. Motion carried (3-0).
5. Approve minutes from previous meeting – A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to approve the minutes from the previous meeting and dispense with the reading. Motion carried (3-0).

7. Discussion/Action items
 - a. Josh Wiesner inquired about the Town’s position on putting up a unique sign for his business along US 41. Dodge County denied his land use permit application due to height restrictions. He plans to seek a variance.
 - b. An update from Mayville EMS was read by the clerk. Mayville EMS had a total of 1,199 calls in 2025 with 74 of those calls for the Town of Lomira. The next EMT class is starting on Feb. 10, 2026, with 18 students enrolled.
 - c. A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to grant an Operator’s license to Sarah Enszer at the Field House Bar & Grill with the condition that any further alcohol related offenses will result in immediate revocation or non-renewal of the license. Motion carried (3-0).
 - d. The current fee schedule was discussed and changes will be approved in February.
 - e. A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to approve Resolution #26-01 Budget Amendment. Motion carried (3-0).
 - f. A motion was made by R. Pribnow and seconded by K. Haefs to approve Resolution #26-02 Remote Attendance Policy. Motion carried (3-0).
