### Annual Town Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order

The Town of Lomira Annual Meeting was brought to order by Chairperson Cody Buerger at 7:00 pm. Board members present: Chairperson Cody Buerger, Supervisor Robbie Pribnow and Supervisor Kurt Haefs. Others present: Town Treasurer Marcia Valle, Town Clerk Sharon Belling, Highway Superintendent Randy Dittberner, and Mike Zahn.

2. Confirmation of Open Meetings notice

The clerk verified that pursuant to WI Statutes §19.81(2) the meeting was published in the Dodge County Pionier and posted at the Lomira Town Hall and on the town's website.

3. Pledge of Allegiance

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

4. Approval of the minutes from last year's annual meeting

Everyone was given a printed copy of the minutes to read. A motion to approve the minutes as printed was made by Robbie Pribnow and seconded by Kurt Haefs. Motion carried (7-0).

5. Review and Approval of 2025 Annual Report

The 2025 Annual Report was reviewed. Highlights included:

- Butternut Road from Super Drive to State Rd 67 (approx. 1 mi.) was excavated, French drains were installed, culverts were replaced, and the road was paved with a 1.5 in. asphalt binder
- Sunnyview Rd was paved from Elm Rd. to the border line with the Town of Leroy (.5 mi.)
- Center Dr. was seal coated from State Rd 49 to State Rd 175 (2.24 mi.)
- West Line Rd., Waas Rd., South Ave., Maple Dr., Spring Valley Rd., and East Ln. were crack filled
- Three culverts were installed on Water Street Rd. in preparation for paving in 2026
- Cody Buerger was appointed as Town Chairperson in August when Jeff Faber announced his retirement after close to 27 years on the Town Board (17 years as Supervisor and 9 years as Chairperson).
- Ergo Bank in Lomira is the official public depository for the Town's financial accounts
- New walk-off carpet tiles were installed in the Town Hall entryway.

6. Set date and time for 2027 Annual Meeting

The date for the Town of Lomira Annual Meeting was set for Tuesday, April 20, 2027 at 7:00 pm.

7. Other Business

- a. A motion was made by Sharon Belling and seconded by Randy Dittberner to establish hourly compensation for elected officials performing temporary or part-time work for the Town at the same rate as part-time employees for the various positions. Motion carried (7-0).

- b. Recognition was given to Marcia Valle for 25 years as Town treasurer and to Randy Dittberner for 40 years as Highway Superintendent.
